CHINA SHAKES THE WORLD: A REVOLUTIONARY REMAKING OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORDER WITH GORDON G. CHANG '73,

J.D. '76



Many say we are competing with China inside the existing international order. Unfortunately, that's not the way Xi Jinping sees it. The aggressive leader is trying to impose

worldwide Chinese rule.

Xi has domestic incentives, like a faltering economy, that are pushing him to act belligerently against neighboring countries and the United States. His regime is now fighting faraway proxy wars on three continents, and with his belligerent tactics he has obviously made the decision to risk war close to home.

China's leader has a low threshold of risk, and he can now take us by surprise.

Gordon G. Chang '73, J.D. '76 is the author of *The Coming Collapse of China*, *China Is Going to War*, and the upcoming *Plan Red: China's Project to Destroy America*.

Chang's writings on China and North Korea have appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *The National Interest*, *The American Conservative*, *Commentary*, *National Review*, and *Barron's*. He is a columnist at *Newsweek* and writes regularly for *The Hill*. He also served two terms as a trustee of Cornell University.
