The Club was housed in various locations including the Waldorf, Royalton, and Barclays Hotel.

1985-1989

The Club found its current home at 6 East 44th Street. Formerly the offices of the Chicago Pneumatic Tool Corporation, the building was a gift to Cornell University.

2014

The Club celebrated its 25th Anniversary and recognition as a Five Star Club -A Platinum Club of America.
