Founded by Cornell University graduates in 1889, The Cornell Club-New York has been in existence in Manhattan for over a century. The Club is a place to dine with family and friends, host a meeting or social event in a private dining room, enjoy a restful stay in an overnight guest room, and foster intellectual, social, and cultural growth through networking and club programs.

In 1989, through the generosity of an alumnus anonymous donor and Member of The Club, our permanent home became 6 East 44th Street. Enriched in tradition of higher education, community service, and continual learning, The Club maintains its relationship with Cornell University along with Weill Cornell Medical Center and Cornell Tech, both of which are located in New York City.

Nestled on Club Row, The Cornell Club is a 14 story brownstone featuring 48 finely appointed overnight guest rooms on our upper floors. The Club's main floor reflects a warm and welcoming ambiance. Completing the first floor, The Club offers its Members a Tap & Grill Room and Business Center. The second floor is home to our formal Cayuga Dining Room and Cayuga Lounge. The A.D. White Library is located on the third floor and offers Members relaxation coupled with quiet work areas. On the fourth and fifth floors of The Club, one will find the perfect venues where Members have hosted family, friends, and colleagues throughout our club's history. These rooms are also utilized to accommodate The Club's many prominent speakers and private dining programs. Located on the entire sixth floor is the Health



& Fitness Center, featuring state-ofthe-art equipment, Peloton Bikes, private trainers, a massage therapist, and course instructors.

As The Club kicks off our 35th Anniversary at our 44th Street location, we will be celebrating our inaugural "1989" Members, and marking the new traditions that will be forged with our newest Members. GOVERNANCE AND PRUDENT FISCAL MANAGEMENT

- The Club has the lowest dues structure (in comparison to peer clubs).
- The Cornell Club maintains a hybrid model of governance since The Club is owned by Cornell University. There is clear separation between governance and Management and also clear separation between University and Club Governance.



- The General Manager reports to the Chairman of the Board.
- The General Manager and staff provide the day-to-day management of The Club.
- The Program Committee is chaired by a board member who oversees an active group of club volunteers.
- The recently formed Young Alumni Committee offer a robust calendar of social and networking events.

The Cornell Club-New York History

—	1889	A small group of Alumni formed The Cornell Club of New York.
—	1900	The Club rented rooms at the Royalton Apartment Hotel on West 44th Street.
—	1900~ 1939	The Club moved from the Royalton Apartment Hotel to 65 Park Avenue and then to Madison Avenue at 38th Street.
•	1939	On its 50 th anniversary, The Club moved uptown to the Hotel Barclay (now the InterContinental) at 48 th Street.
—	1962	The Club moved further uptown to 50 th Street at 3 rd Avenue.
•	1982	The Club started searching for a permanent home while temporarily relocating to first the Women's National Headquarters and then to NYU's Town Hall facility.
•	1985~ 1989	The Club found its current home at 6 East 44 th Street in midtown Manhattan, between Fifth & Madison Avenues. Formerly the offices of the Chicago Pneumatic Tube Corporation, the building was a gift to Cornell University. After the University acquired the building in 1986, a three year renovation was undertaken. The firm of Gensler & Associates of San Francisco, CA completed the renovation.
—	1989	The Clubhouse opened its doors to Cornell Club Members on December 1 st , 1989.
—	2009	The Club celebrated its 20 th Anniversary at its current clubhouse.
•	2014	The Club celebrated its 25 th Anniversary at its current clubhouse and its recognition as A Five Star Club - A Platinum Club of America.
•	2019	The Club celebrated its 30 th Anniversary along with renovations to The Club's first floor, Cayuga Dining Room and Cayuga Lounge!
•	2024	Preparations are underway to mark The Club's 35 th Anniversary on December 1 st !
